The price is calculated per room and is \$390. That's two (or one) people for just \$390 per room.

You are welcome to drive to the site but vehicles are not allowed on the actual site, so a shuttle bus is provided from the entrance. You can also choose to go by train to Central, Ferry to Manly and then either public bus or taxi to nearby North Head.

Out of pocket expenses will be for lunch on both Thursday and Friday plus drinks etc.

The venue advised that there is walking, and stairs involved and that a moderate level of fitness and mobility is advised for participants.

There is a shuttle bus that is available on call for transfers around the site. This shuttle bus also transfers participants from the front gate to/from accommodation and to various venues on site. No private cars on site.

 There are only ten rooms available currently, and you are advised to use the booking link to secure your place as soon as possible.

When? The planned dates are Thursday, 28th August and return Friday 29th August.

Payment? A deposit of \$100 per room is required when booking. After you have filled out the booking form, please go to your financial institution's app to pay the \$100 into the club account.

Final payment will be required by Friday, 1st August and cancellations/refunds will be accepted up until Friday, 8th August.
